



In Japan, when we think of March, we think of one certain event known as "Hinamatsuri". We'd like to introduce one form of this event, the Wakasa Takahama Hinamatsuri, that wishes for the healthy growth and development of children. This an event starting on February 18th (Sat.) in which approximately 70 shops and normal households display their proud Hina dolls for 14 days. Magnificent stair-shaped decorative stages adorned with rare Hina dolls from the Meiji Era and the like are unveiled for all to see. In addition, Takahama Town Cultural Hall lines up 5 seven-row Hina decorations and puts up hanging Hina dolls with other decorations so visitors have a chance to meet this impressive Hina dolls. It's often said that spirits dwell within dolls, and with the makeup and costumes that have been carefully applied to these dolls one by one, they look like they could come alive at any second! It's also nice to walk around the streets of Takahama with your kids as you immerse yourself in some traditional Japanese culture.
