It's Census Time!

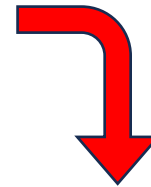
The census, which includes all individuals and households in Japan, is the most important survey in the country.

- ☒ The survey takes place every five years (this year, it will be held on October 1, 2025)
- ☒ Non-Japanese citizens are also included in the census.
- ☒ At the end of September, census staff will visit your home to drop off the census paperwork.
- ☒ You can answer the survey online or on the physical documents before the deadline.

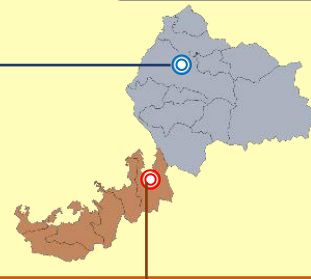
