

Japanese Language Lessons- Outline

Teachers	The Reinan Center employs volunteer staff to teach Japanese Language lessons. All volunteers have completed a 50-hours Japanese language teacher training seminar funded by the Fukui International Association or training of a similar nature.
Methodology	In principle, classes teach the Japanese language through exclusive use of Japanese.
Places	Reinan Center Public facilities within Tsuruga City
Applications	Fill out and submit the application form available at the Reinan center. The center will contact a teacher, and an interview will be arranged for the following day.
TextBooks	*The beginner Level classes use <i>Minna no Nihongo</i> (¥2600). Text for intermediate and advanced students will be decided on a case-by-case basis. *Students may either purchase the textbook at a bookstore or photocopy the necessary pages from the teacher's text. The students must bear the photocopy cost(¥10 per page)
Fees	¥500 per person, per lesson. Please note that payment methods may differ depending on the group. *1: Class expenses may increase or decrease slightly depending on facility rental fees and teacher employment fees. *2: Please confer with your teacher regarding requests from work(including formal dispatches).

※NOTICE

*Please contact your teacher (or, when your teacher is unavailable, the Reinan Center) ahead of time if you will be unable to attend a lesson due to work, visits home, etc.

※Since the volunteers come to the Reinan center for the lesson, it is very important that you contact them if you will be unable to attend.

*Students who are absent three consecutive times will be considered withdrawn from lessons.

*Please turn off cellular phones during lessons.

*If you have any requests or problems with the lessons, please contact either the teacher in charge or the Reinan center.
