#### **Elementary Conversation Level 1**

This course begins with the *hiragana* and *katakana* scripts and systematically covers grammatical structures used in basic conversation. (*Minna no Nihongo Vol. 1*, chapters 1-8.)

The course also covers vocabulary and expressions often used in typical daily situations (at the post office or train station, when shopping, etc.)

#### **Elementary Conversation Level 2**

A continuation of Level 1, this course covers chapters 8-18 of *Minna no Nihongo Vol. 1*. It also covers vocabulary and expressions used in daily life.

#### **Elementary Conversation Level 3**

A continuation of Level 2, this course covers chapters 19-25 of *Minna no Nihongo Vol. 1*. It also covers vocabulary and expressions used in daily life.
