

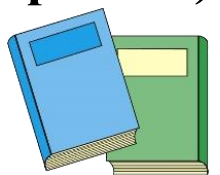


Hello Work Takefu Office Relocation

Special Cash Payments

The benefit will be 100,000 yen per person.



Who is eligible? Those who are registered with Basic Resident Registration System as of April 27, 2020.

*The recipient will be the head of household (family representative, main payer of household living expenses).

When will applications begin? The start date for accepting applications will vary between each municipality.

Please apply within three months from the start of applications in your municipality.

How can I apply?

Local municipalities will send an application form by mail with your name and date of birth printed. Please apply by mail or online as prevention measure against the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

Postal applications

Fill out the form with the required information, including the account number for the bank transfer, and send it along with necessary documents ① and ② to your local municipality.



【Necessary Documents】

① Identity verification documents (Copy of your residence card, My Number Card or driver's license etc.)

② Copy of a bankbook, cash card or printed screen of an online banking service which shows the name of financial institution, account number and the name of account holder

Online applications

If you have a My Number Card, you can apply online from the Myna-Portal website (<https://myna.go.jp/>).
If you do not have a My Number Card, please apply by mail.



【Necessary Documents】

Copy of a bankbook, cash card or printed screen of an online banking service that shows the name of financial institution, account number and the name of account holder

- The payment will be transferred to the bank account for each household.

FAQs

Q. Are foreign trainees and international students eligible for this benefit?

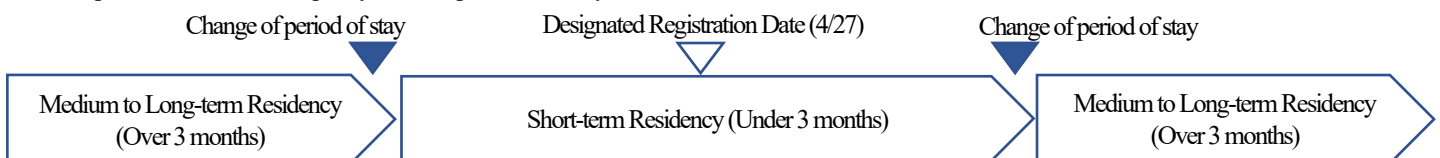
A. Foreigners registered with Basic Resident Registration System as of April 27, 2020, are eligible.

Please note that foreigners on short stays or illegal residents are not registered with Basic Resident Registration System and are not eligible.

*Change in Policy Regarding Short-term Foreign Residents' Eligibility for the Special Cash Payment

In accordance with internal communications received from the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communication on May 19th, the policy regarding short term residents receiving the Special Cash Payment has changed. There are cases where a foreign resident may qualify to receive the Special Cash Payment even if their residence status was designated as short-term residency and thus were not registered in the Basic Residence Registration System on the designated registration date (April 27th). Q. I live in a municipality different from that on my residence registry, as I am a victim of domestic violence.

What should I do?

A. To receive the benefit, please contact the municipality of your current residence as soon as possible and explain that you are taking shelter there from domestic violence.
