Obama city faces Wakasa Bay, is a rare coastline that is heavily indented by the Sea of Japan. The Uchitomi Peninsula has been shaved to a sharp tip over many years by the waves of the sea, and there is an area known as the Sotomo Arch where there almost 6 km worth of strangely eroded rocks and caverns

Seeing the current state of the natural erosion of the 6 km of the arch is truly splendid. It's impossible to look at the art that the sea has made and not feel a sense of romanticism! You can also enjoy Sotomo Arch's scenery from cruises that leave from Wakasa's Fisherman's Wharf! The real beauty of Sotomo Arch are the specifically named natural formations, such as the Daimon Komon gate rocks or Meoto Kame Rock, which resembles two turtles cuddling together! You should come witness these natural treasures with your own eyes!
