Hello from REINAN!

For this newsletter, we'd like to introduce a local specialty of Natashou from within the town of Ooi. When people think of Natashou, they think of pickled vegetables and Japanese yams. Natashou's pickled vegetables are made from homegrown vegetables that are topped with just a little bit of salt. Natashou's topography and climate naturally grow Japanese yams, the king of mountain vegetables, throughout the region. Out of all the yams related to them, naturally grown yams are higher in fiber and vitamin E. Those yams are then turned into dough and made into special product like Japanese yam soba. Also, Roadside Station "Natashou" has unusual sweets that you can't eat anywhere else. One such sweet is a type of ice cream made from Japanese yams, known as "Japanese yam gelato", and the refreshing taste of milk and Japanese yams has become quite popular. The road that links Wakasa and Kyoto: Roadside Station "Natashou". If you go to Natashou, you should stop by!
